- 1. I was present at the P'egp'ig'lha Community Centre, 59 Retasket Street, T'it'q'et Reserve # 1, Lillooet, BC. on the 27th day of June 2019 when Registered Voters voted concerning approval of the T'it'q'et Land Code and their Individual Agreement in accordance with the T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process. In addition I arranged for the appointment of an assistant verifier who was present at the P'egp'ig'lha Community Centre, 59 Retasket Street, T'it'q'et Reserve # 1, Lillooet, BC on June 13, 2019, when T'it'q'et First Nation's eligible voters voted concerning the approval of the T'it'q'et First Nation Land Code and their Individual Agreement in accordance with the T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process.
- 2. A copy of the Notice of Vote is attached as Exhibit "1" to this Declaration.
- 3. In accordance with clause 8.1 of the *T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process*, the Ratification Officer posted the Notice of Vote at least 31 days prior to the first Voting Day.
- 4. In accordance with clause 8.2 of the *T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process*, I arranged for the Notice of Vote to be published in the Vancouver Sun/Province on May 31 and June 5, 2019, Bridge River Lillooet News on June 5 and June 12, 2019, Seattle Times on May 31, 2019 and the Kamloops This Week on June 5 and June 12, 2019. These seven (7) publications of the notice met the requirement to publish the notice at least 28 days prior to the first Voting Day.
- 5. In accordance with clause 9.2 of the *T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process*, a copy of the Notice of Vote and the documents listed in clause 9.1 were sent to each person on the List of Voters at their last known address at least 31 days prior to the Voting Day.
- 6. In accordance with clauses 9.3 and 9.4 of the *T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process*, the following community information processes were carried out: door-to-door visits, community information meetings and telephone contacts were made in the community.
- 7. In accordance with clause 10.1 of the *T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process*, the information package was sent to any persons who are not Members who hold an interest in T'it'q'et First Nation Land at least 31 days prior to the first Voting Day.
- 8. The names of **358** Eligible Voters appeared on the List of Voters.
- 9. The number of participating Eligible Voters was 114
- 10. The number of participating Eligible Voters who constituted a majority was 58.
- 11. The results of the Ratification Vote are as follows:
 - (a) <u>16</u> mail-in ballots were cast in the Ratification Vote in accordance with clause 13 of the *T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process*;

(b) <u>62</u> regular ballots were cast in the Ratification Vote in accordance with clauses 14, 15, 16 and 17 of the <i>T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process</i> ;
(c) <u>0</u> ballots were spoiled as provided in clause 19 of the <i>T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process</i> ;
(d) 35 electronic ballots were cast in the Ratification Vote in accordance with clauses 17 and 18 of the T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process;
(e) <u>0</u> ballots were cancelled in accordance with clause 19 of the <i>T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process</i> ;
(f) <u>0</u> ballots were rejected in accordance with clause 19 of the <i>T'it'q'et Land Code Community Ratification Process</i> ;
(g) _71ballots were marked "YES" for the Ballot Question and counted;
(h) 43ballots were marked "NO" for the Ballot Question and counted.
12. Based on the need for the number of votes in favour of the Ballot Question to meet or exceed 50 % plus 1 of the number of participating Eligible Voters in item 9 above, the Ratification Documents were <i>approved</i> by the Registered Voters.
