DO HEREBY RESOLVE:

**STATE OF EMERGENCY-
UPDATED**

For the safety of our members, T'it'q'et has declared a State of Emergency on March 27, 2020 for the T'it'q'et reserve communities of IR 1, 1B, 2, 3, 4 and 5, collectively known as T'it'q'et, for precautionary reasons related to COVID-19. Currently T'it'q'et is in Phase 3 of the T'it'q'et Restart Plan.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

- Within all T'it'q'et reserve communities, every person must follow physical distancing requirements; these requirements apply to all residents, staff and authorized non-residents.
- Traffic into T'it'q'et Community is restricted to T'it'q'et Community residents, staff, essential services and authorized non-residents. Authorized non-resident is further defined in Appendix A.
- T'it'q'et Members not ordinarily a resident of T'it'q'et, who currently live in urban centres or out of province, will be permitted to return to the T'it'q'et Community to take up long-term residence but must contact the T'it'q'et Administration for instructions prior to arrival into the community.
- **DELIVERIES OF GOODS & SERVICES** upon approval of Chief and Council, deliveries into T'it'q'et will be permitted, these deliveries require minimal contact with community residents. This includes homebased businesses.
- Social gathering are limited to 10 guest and must follow COVID-19 safe physical distancing guidelines. If the social gathering is taking place at a residence in community, the gathering size must be limited to 10 guests, not including those that reside permanently in the home.
- Ceremonial and cultural gatherings are limited to 10 participants and must follow COVID-19 safe physical distancing guidelines.

Failure to respect this Emergency Order will result in enforcement actions and penalties by T'it'q'et.


