

These St'át'imc ceremonial practices have been applied to current day funerals and cemeteries:

- Children must be 12 years of age or older to enter the graveyard during funeral services.
- Persons may not remain in the graveyard after 3 p.m. each day.
- Women on their moon time may not be present during funeral services.
- Persons under the influence of intoxicants may not enter the graveyard.
- Hand washing is required when leaving the graveyard.
- Do not leave anything not intended for the grave of loved ones inside of the graveyard.
- When graves fall, they must be refilled with soil and rocks.
- When cleaning a grave, do not take away from the graveyard any items left for the loved ones. Items may be burned within the graveyard fire pit following fire restrictions, or they can be left in the marked bin to be burned later.
